Alexander Anderson, husband of Nancy Long, might be the son of Josiah McNair Anderson for these reasons:

- 1) Alexander is very near the correct age. Alexander's, son of Josiah, age on Marion County, Tenn. census reports: age 17 in 1850 with Josiah, age 26 in 1860 with Nancy, age 36 in 1870 with Nancy, age 49 in 1880 with Nancy, age 69 in 1900 with Nancy.
- 2) Alexander lives in the vicinity of Josiah.
- 3) No other Alexander near the correct age lives in the area.
- 4) Alexander's first two sons are named James and Madison; Josiah has a brother, son and nephew named James Madison.

Reasons I may be wrong:

- 1) Page 7 of "Leaves from the Family Tree" says Alexander Anderson, son of Josiah McNair Anderson, married 1st Elizabeth Pope then 2nd Esther Shelton. It makes no mention of a marriage to Nancy Long, nor does it mention his children.
- 2) Various census reports list Alexander's parents as being born in Virginia. "Leaves from the Family Tree" and the 1850 census say Josiah was born in Tennessee.
- 3) The 1900 census says Alexander's birthday is in June 1830, "Leaves from the Family Tree" says his birthday is Dec 25, 1832.

How accurate is "Leaves from the Family Tree?"

Rhonda Powell Holders' "MURDER OF COLONEL McNAIR ANDERSON" in "The Searchers," vol 1, issue #3, page 56, summarizes two newspaper articles (11/8/1861 and 11/14/1861) about Josiah's murder. In this article she says he was fatally stabbed in the back twice while mounting his horse after casting a ballot; "Leaves from the Family Tree," page 7, says he was shot while making a speech. "Leaves from the Family Tree" does not indicate its' sources.

Feb 1996: Since writing the above notes I have discovered "The Story of Marion County, It's People and Places" Vol 1 by the Marion Co. Historical Society. The story of Peter Looney Anderson (F23) on pages 126 and 127 says he and his brother Alexander, husband of Nancy Long, are the son's of James and Hetty (Looney) Anderson. I'm not sure where the author got this information, however, I think Peter and Josiah were closely related, possibly brothers, because of the recurring use of the names Alexander and Josiah (Peter has another son named Josiah). He was married to Nancy LONG on April 11, 1857 in Hamilton County, Tennessee.
