Capt. John ANDERSON^{1,2} was born on May 5, 1750 in Augusta County, Virginia. He died on October 13, 1817 in Scott County, Virginia (at the "Block House"). He was buried in Morrison graveyard, about five miles southeast of Gate City, Va..

Merged General Note:

Fought in the American Revolution. Lived at he Block House in southwest Virginia where parties assembled to begin their journeys on the Wilderness Road.

Capt. John ANDERSON was married to Rebecca MAXWELL (daughter of MAXWELL) on January 12, 1775 in Virginia.¹ **Rebecca MAXWELL**¹ was born on August 7, 1753 in Augusta County, Virginia. She died on February 21, 1824 in Scott County, Virginia (at the "Block House"). Capt. John ANDERSON and Rebecca MAXWELL had the following children:

Lt. Col. John ANDERSON Jr. was married to Elizabeth MCNAIR (daughter of David MCNAIR and Elizabeth ALLEN) on November 12, 1805.¹ Lt. Col. John ANDERSON Jr. and Elizabeth MCNAIR had the following children:

A. **Louisa Maxwell ANDERSON**³ was born on September 8, 1806 in Bledsoe County, Tennessee. She died on January 30, 1876.

Louisa Maxwell ANDERSON was married to Allen KIRKLAND on June 8, 1826.

B. **Col. Josiah McNair ANDERSON**^{4,5} was born on November 29, 1807 in Bledsoe County, Tennessee. He died on November 8, 1861 in Marion County, Tennessee.

Col. Josiah McNair ANDERSON was married to Nancy LAMB (daughter of Alexander LAMB and _____ CARMAC) on December 25, 1828 in Bledsoe County, Tennessee. **Nancy LAMB**⁶ was born on September 28, 1807 in Bledsoe County, Tennessee. She died on March 29, 1860 in Marion County, Tennessee. Col. Josiah McNair ANDERSON and Nancy LAMB had the following children:

C. **James Madison ANDERSON**¹⁷ was born on February 25, 1809 in Bledsoe County, Tennessee. James Madison served as 4th President of the United States from 1809 till 1817.

James Madison ANDERSON was married to Jane LAMB.

James Madison ANDERSON was married to Sarah HIXSON.

D. **Elizabeth Ann ANDERSON**¹⁸ was born on April 1, 1811 in Bledsoe County, Tennessee.

Elizabeth Ann ANDERSON was married to Hugh LAMB.

E. **Col. John ANDERSON III**² was born on December 2, 1814 in Pikeville, Tennessee. He died on July 20, 1902 in Long Savannah, James County, Tennessee. He was buried in Anderson Cemetery. John Anderson, Esq., a prominent citizen and planter of the Fourth District, was born in Bledsoe County, December 2, 1814. He is the youngest and only surviving one of six children of Col. John and Betsy (McNair) Anderson. Both parents were of Scotch descent. The father was born in Scott County, Va., October 5, 1778, and died October 27, 1814, while on a march with his regiment to New Orleans. He was colonel of the State militia. He was by occupation a farmer and merchant. The mother was born near Knoxville, Tenn., March 31, 1783, and married in Knox County, November 5, 1805. Her death occurred August 13, 1859, near Pikeville, Bledsoe County. They were devout members of the Presbyterian Church. Our subject received a good education in his native county. In his early days he dealt in corn on the Sequatchie River. In 1835 he moved to Hamilton (now James) County, and was one of the first settlers. He opened the first store at Georgetown, where for a few years he engaged in mercantile business. In 1838 he purchased and settled upon the farm where he now resides. Since that date he has given his attention to agriculture and live stock trading. From 1836 to 1886 he was the postmaster at Georgetown. The office was for a time in the village, and then at his residence. For forty years he was justice of the peace. He resigned in 1886. He is a warm Republican. In the latter part of 1835 he married Miss G. Allen, who bore him two children; she died in 1838, an earnest member of the Methodist Church. January 16, 1840, our subject wedded Purlymly Luttrell, by whom he has had ten children. Five of his sons served in the Federal Army. J M received a mortal wound September 27, 1864, at Pulaski, Tenn., while engaged with Forrest's forces. He was brought home by his father, and died the following 24th of December. Mr. and Mrs. Anderson are active members of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church.

Col. John ANDERSON III was married to Purlymly LUTTRELL (daughter of Rev. George W. LUTTRELL Sr. and Jane FRANCIS) on January 16, 1840 in Tennessee.² **Purlymly LUTTRELL**² was born on October 24, 1819. She died on October 3, 1892. Col. John ANDERSON III and Purlymly LUTTRELL had the following children:

Survivors include his wife, Rubye Anderson; two sons, Jimmy Anderson, Harrison, and Eddie Anderson, Ooltewah; brother, Robert E. Anderson; granddaughter, Melissa Anderson, both of Ooltewah; two nieces.

He was buried on April 29, 1990 in McDonald Eastview Cemetery, Hamilton County, TN.
